Care home capacity at a glance

If someone is no longer able to live at home, or is discharged but needing homecare, it is important to it is important to involve the necessary care promptly, even if only as an interim solution. This requires healthcare workers to have an upto-date overview of regional longand short-term care capacity and / or homecare. The Capacity Tracker enables care organisations to find a suitable place or professional quickly, meaning that the patient often receives a better level of care.

Regional coordination of care

The Capacity Tracker allows GPs and hospitals making referrals to find a bed for patients or the appropriate homecare in their own region more quickly. Care homes, nursing homes and home care organisations keep precise records of available beds and employees in this system. Healthcare provider capacity is always up to date and endless phone calls can be avoided.

GPs and transfer departments

Each region uses the coordination feature differently. The GP is an important link when making immediate referrals and organising first-line accommodation. Transfer departments try their hardest to organise the right home care or (temporary) place in a nursing home when patients are discharged from hospital. The Capacity Tracker helps them to find a good space quickly.

Coordination with ambulance, GP and mental health services

The ambulance dispatch centre, GP services (HAP) and the mental healthcare crisis service (GGZ) are increasingly connected to the coordination feature as a regional coordination point (ReCo) or healthcare coordination centre (ZCC). In this way, the different departments can find each other more easily and decide on the right place for a patient more quickly.
